Furthermore, I agree not to go back on the course after finishing. I am fully aware that allowing someone else to wear my race chip, switching race chips or running under a false name is a fraudulent act and I agree not to do this. Knowing these facts, and in consideration of you accepting my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and unconditionally waive and release and discharge the USATF/Oklahoma/LDR, City and State Police Departments, race officials, volunteers and any and all sponsors, including any and all of their agents, employees, assigns or anyone acting for or on their behalf from any and all claims or liability for death, personal injury or property damage of any kind or nature whatsoever arising out of, or in the course of, my participating in this event whether same be cause by negligence or fault. This release and waiver extends to all claims of every kind or nature whatsoever, foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown. The undersigned further grants full permission to sponsors and or agents authorized by them to use any photographs, video tapes, motion pictures, recordings or any other record of this event for any purpose. 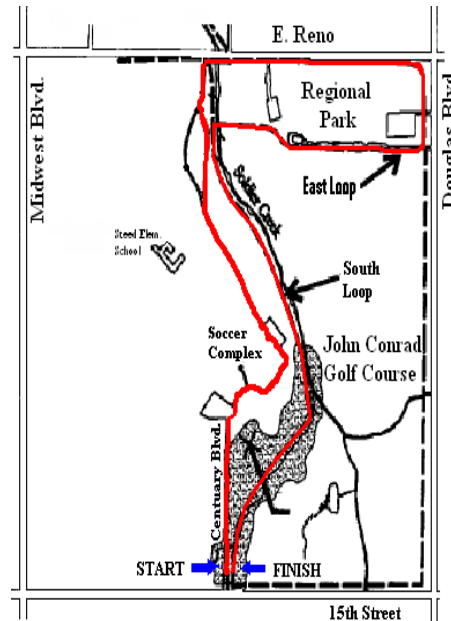

The Event

This is the 5th Annual 5k Nightlight Run . The goal is to allow runners one night to enjoy the beauty of Holiday Lights Spectacular the only way any runner would want, by running through. All proceeds go to the Holiday Lights Spectacular Fund to perpetuate the lights.

The Location

Midwest City is located east of Oklahoma City on Interstate 40. Exit Douglas Blvd. and go north 1 mile to 15th street, turn West and proceed to Century Blvd. The Race will begin from Century Blvd. and go through Joe B. Barnes Regional Park.



The Course

The Nightlight Run will start at the entrance to the Holiday lights Spectacular. The course will wind through the lit displays for a magical night run illuminated by holiday lights. At the northern end of Morris McGee Drive runners will take a right heading east into the jogging path of Regional Park. The course will continue east around the Reno Swim & Slide complex then turn south until it reaches Joe B. Barnes Drive. Runners will run west until reaching "Memory Lane" and follow the trail through the Bird watch area to the end on Century Blvd. Splits at Ks, traffic control, emergency first aid and a water station will be available. Major entrances to the park will be held for runners as well as walkers.

The event will adhere to USA Track & Field Rules.

Baby joggers, strollers, pushed wheelchairs and wheels of any kind (except competitive wheelchairs in a separate race), head-phones and animals are forbidden on the course.

Awards & Categories

A Holiday Spirit Award will be given to the runner with the most festive attire. First, second and third place awards will be given.

Entrants will be placed in standard age brackets. First, second and third place winners in each age bracket will receive medallions. Overall male and female winners will receive trophies. Results will be posted the following Monday on www.dgroadracing.com.
