The Grants department began in 1978 and has since benefited the community in numerous ways!

Since 1978:

594 Single family homes have been **rehabilitated**

455 Low income households have received **emergency repair**

493 First time homebuyers have received **down payment assistance**

That is over \$1,150,000 in Homebuyer Assistance!!

73 Households have benefited from **sewer/water tie-ons**

1,943 Children have received **counseling through at-risk programs**

747 Children received **before/after school daycare**

1,780 Children have attended **Head Start programs**

3,442 residents of **Autumn House** benefited from service programs

8,798 **Share-A-Fare** books have been sold to **disabled/senior citizens**

21 Formerly homeless families have benefited from **Transitional Housing**
