

# City of Midwest City Grants Management Department

Midwest City uses the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) combined with additional funding sources to improve housing, neighborhoods, community services, and expand economic opportunities for low and moderate income citizens. The Grants department began in 1978 and has since benefited the community in numerous ways!

Since 1978:

599 Single family homes have been **rehabilitated**

534 Low income households have received **emergency repair**

552 First time homebuyers have received **down payment assistance**

**That is over \$1,403,300 in Homebuyer Assistance!!**

73 Households have benefited from sewer/water tie-ons

2,587 Children have received counseling through **at-risk programs**

813 Children received **before/after school daycare scholarships**

2,200 Children have attended **Head Start** programs

3,959 residents of **Autumn House** benefited from service programs

11,179 **Share-A-Fare** books have been sold to disabled/senior citizens

27 Formerly homeless families have benefited from **Transitional Housing**
