Citizens may also address the Council on individual concerns at the end of the agenda when the Chairperson announces "Citizen Participation." Citizens' Participation <u>is not provided as a general forum</u> and <u>not</u> a forum for support/opposition of publicly announced or declared candidates for public office/issues, as such, they will not be allowed to be discussed under Citizens Participation. Citizens will not be allowed to campaign on any political issue during the Council meeting. Comments must strictly concern specific Council actions or policies. **PLEASE LIMIT YOUR COMMENTS TO 2 MINUTES.**

Special Considerations for Attendance at the OKC Convention Center:
