8	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWEST CITY, OKLAHOMA:

10	<b>ORDINANCE</b>

12	Section 1. That the Midwest City Municipal Code, Chapter 9 Buildings and Building Regulations,
13	Article II, Builder's Advisory Board, Section 9-17, Members; is hereby amended to read as
14	follows:
15	(a) The hailden's advisery board shall consist of seven (7) members to be appointed by the mayor
16 17	(a) The builder's advisory board shall consist of seven (7) members to be appointed by the mayor and approved by the city council. The members of the board shall be chosen from either:
18	and approved by the city council. The members of the board shari be chosen from cities.
19	(1) residents of the city at large with reference to their fitness for such office: or
20	(1) residents of the easy at large with residence to their states for their extraction of
21	(2) ownership, operation or involvement in the building, construction or development
22	business within the city.
23	
24	(b) The members of the builder's advisory board shall hold office until their successors are
25	appointed; except that the in first instance, three (3) members shall be appointed for three (3)
26	years, two (2) members for two (2) years, two (2) members for one (1) year. The mayor shall be
27	an ex officio member of the board.
28 29	(c) Members may be removed for cause by the mayor with approval of the city council. Absences
30	from meetings by board members shall be governed by section 2-28 of the Municipal Code.
31	Vacancies shall be filled for and unexpired term in the same manner as appointment.
32	vacancies shall be fined for and anexpired term in the same marmer as appointment.
33	(d) The member of the builder's advisory board shall serve without pay.
34	
35	Section 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
36	repealed.
37	
38	Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or portion of this ordinance is for
39	any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions
40	of the ordinance.
