(b) Animals abandoned to the Midwest City Animal Welfare Shelter or for whom the municipal court has divested ownership due to neglect or abuse may be: (1) Sold or adopted to the public; (2) Transferred to a nonprofit animal shelter, pound, rescue, or society for the protection of animals, from which the animals so transferred may be sold or adopted; or (3) Humanely destroyed, a.If the court determines it is in the best interests or the animal, public health, or public safety; or b. The designee of the city manager determines it is in the best interests or the animal, public health, or public safety.
