AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING THE ZONING DISTRICT OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE FROM PUD, PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT GOVERENED BY R-MD, MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO C-3, COMMUNITY COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, AND DIRECTING AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING DISTRICT MAP TO REFLECT THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE PROPERTY'S ZONING DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWEST CITY, OKLAHOMA:

ORDINANCE

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the zoning district of the following described property is hereby reclassified from PUD, Planned Unit Development governed by R-MD, Medium Density Residential to C-3, Community Commercial District subject to the conditions contained in the PC-2145 file, and that the official Zoning District Map shall be amended to reflect the reclassification of the property's zoning district as specified in this ordinance:

For the property described as a tract of land lying in the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section Thirty-Four (34), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Two (2) West of the Indian Meridian in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Section 34; Thence N 89°51'43" E along the South line of said SW/4 a distance of 798.49 feet; Thence N 00°36'11" W and parallel with the West line of said SW/4 a distance of 249.09 feet to the Point of Beginning; Thence continuing N 00°36'11" W and parallel to the West line of said SW/4 a distance of 140.70 feet; Thence N 89°23'49" E a distance 147.92 feet; Thence S 45°36'11" E a distance of 35.36 feet; Thence S 00°36'11" E and a distance of 115.70 feet; Thence S 89°23'49" W a distance of 172.92 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. <u>REPEALER</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.
