

Citizen's Police Academy Midwest City Police

The Midwest City Police Department's Citizen's Academy is designed for people who are interested in the possibility of taking an inside look of the Midwest City Police Department's daily operations. Class participants will be introduced to many different programs and resources the police department has to offer. Academy members will get a tour of the police department, jail, Forensic Lab and 911 center. Members will also receive presentations over patrol techniques, K-9 demo, defensive tactics, Law enforcement driving demo, investigations, firearms and SWAT demos. There will also be a DUI education night and crisis intervention/verbal de-escalation presentation. The program is sociable and educational. Members will meet others from the community who share the same concerns and ambitions.

The academy is held one night a week (currently on Thursdays) from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM for 13 weeks. The class is set to begin Fall 2024 (Dates TBD).

Students receive a class shirt, class photo, graduation certificate and video of their class. There is no charge for attending although **class size is limited**. The academy is normally open to people 21 years of age or older who live or work in Midwest City. This includes Tinker Air Force Base. There are sometimes exceptions.
